## WHAT IS A MEDICAL HOME?

A Medical Home is a place for uninsured Pinellas County residents to receive primary, non-emergency health care even after regular business hours.

Once a Medical Home is established, patients will not have to wait hours in an emergency room for minor but painful problems. Patients learn how to take care of medical conditions through preventative medical attention and education.

The professionals working at our Medical Homes care about their patients and show them how to make behavior and lifestyle changes that can result in a healthier life.

- ✓ Pinellas County resident between the ages of 18 and 64
- ✓ Uninsured and not eligible for other medical public assistance
- ✓ U.S. Citizen, non-sponsored legal permanent resident or refugee/asylum seeker
- ✓ Meet federal income guidelines

## WHAT DO WE PROVIDE?

- Primary medical care, including lab work and necessary tests
- Wellness and prevention services, including annual physicals
- Prescriptions
- Cancer screenings
- Nutrition education and counseling
- Behavior health screening and referral for treatment
- Case management services
- Disease management services
- Referral for relief of dental pain
- Limited specialty care
- Access to volunteer services
